For All Friends of Folk Events:

- We provide a high quality sound system
- We provide staff to handle artist merchandise sales, and we add \$1 for each item (i.e. CD, T-shirt, etc.) as a fundraiser for our not-for-profit organization.
- Most terms are negotiable, so if you'd like to discuss something, please bring it up.
- Children ages 12 and younger are typically free at our events.

Delmarva Folk Festival:

- The Festival will be held the first Saturday in October on a rural site in Central Delaware that can hold up to 500 people.
- To date, we have had no major corporate sponsorships, so we can't afford to pay like many of the major Folk Festivals can. Please keep that in mind when indicating your required fee. We are a passionate, all-volunteer grassroots organization, putting on a small, intimate, but professional quality Folk Festival.
- We present a variety of genres, including folk, old-time, jazz, blues, bluegrass, Children's and Celtic.

- The **absolute deadline** for receipt of submission of artists, with a CD (and DVD if you have one) of their work is January 15. Selection is done by the Delaware Friends of Folk board vote. If you can submit earlier it would be appreciated, so it will give us time to process your submission and distribute samples to the Board. We hope to have all selections done by March 15, so please do not contact us for status until that time.
- After the selection process, all submissions will be combined with other CD donations into a "Tub O'Tunes" and raffled off as a collection at the festival as a fundraiser for our organization. We would appreciate an autograph on the CD to help increase its value for the raffle.

Coffeehouses:

- Coffeehouses are typically held once a month in January, March, April, May, September, October, and November at the Music department addition at the Wesley Chapel (part of Wesley College) in downtown Dover Delaware. The building is a beautiful old church, which is considered a landmark in the town. The performance occurs in a room next to the Sanctuary that holds at least 60 people

- Also, please note that our coffeehouses in February, July and December are Open Mic format. If you're close by on one of those dates, this can be an excellent way to introduce yourself to the organization's membership. It's not unheard of to see an Open Mic performer wind up with a coffeehouse booking.
- Our standard admission price is \$5 for members, \$7 for non-members. In rare situations for some more established performers, we have raised the admission price to \$12 for members and \$15 for non-members.
- We sell fresh brewed coffee, tea, soft drinks, and sweet treats. Coffeehouses are alcohol free and family friendly.
